**Medosebna komunikacija v stresnih situacijah: socialna podpora in pomoč** kot zaščitno obvladovanje stresa;

**Bolečina kot večdimensionalni in večvrstni pojav:** od zgodnjih teoretskih konceptov bolečinskega pojava (Descartes, 1662, von Frey, 1890, Goldscheider, 1894, Sinclair in Weddell, 1955), teorije kontrolnih vrat, Melzack-a in Wall-a, 1965, kasnejših psiholoških, psihofizioloških modelov do bio-psiho-socialnega modela Schwartz-a, 1982, Turk-a in Flor-a, 1984.

**Model k bolniku usmerjene obravnave:** Spodbujanje bolnikovega sodelovanja med zdravljenjem. Aktivno poslušanje. Nebesedna komunikacija. Vzpostavljanje zaupanja. Empatično vedenje. Bolnikova vprašanja in zdravnikova pojasnila.

Posredovanje informacij in preverjanje razumevanja ter zapomnitve danih navodil.

Ojačitev bolnikove motiviranosti za vzpostavljanje zdravih navad in življenjskega sloga (intrinzična in ekstrinzična motivacija).

**Motivacijski razgovor:** Model stopenske razgradnje ambivalenze v sprejemanju odločitev in spremicanju navad in sloga.

**Sporočanje slabih novic.** Protokol za sporočanje slabih novic bolniku in njihovim svojcem t.i.m. S-P-I-K-E-S, Buckman, 2005, ima štiri cilje in poteka v šestih stopnjah.

**Izgube in petstopenska teorija o procesu žalovanja.** Vrste izgub. Žalovanje v družini.

Odkloni v poteku žalovanja (CGD). Strokovno nudjenje pomoči. Podporne skupine.

#### Cilji in kompetence:

Študentje se seznanijo s bio-psiho-socialnim modelom zdravja in bolezni. Spoznajo vlogo psiholoških dejavnikov pri ohranjanju in krepitevi zdravja ter psihološke in psihosocialne dejavnike, ki vodijo k pojavu bolezni in vplivajo na potek njenega zdravljenja.

Razvijajo zmožnost empatije, ustrezne oblike sporazumevanja z bolniki in njihovimi svojci v kriznih okoliščinah ter spoznavajo tudi pomen lastne osebnostne ozaveščenosti kot zaščite pred poklicnim izgrevanjem pri delu.

#### Objectives and competences:

Students become familiar to bio-psycho-social model of health and illness. They learn about a role of psychological factors in the maintaining and promoting health, as also about their meaning in the occurrence and course of the disease.

They could develop capability of empathy, appropriate forms of communication with patients and their relatives in crises, and recognize the importance of psychological support and partner relationship with patient, as also importance of personal awareness and growth in the doctor's role.
