Content (syllabus outline):

The education program consists of understanding:

- the basics of cultural competences (knowledge, attitudes and skills) that enable high-quality work with patients from other cultural and social environments,
- the international standards regarding healthcare for migrants, refugees and other patients who do not speak the dominant language of the host country, and legal aspects of healthcare provision of individuals with different legal statuses in Slovenia,
- the issues of inequality in healthcare and the consequences of prejudice, bias and discrimination in healthcare provision,
- the issue of language in clinical environment and the consequences of language and cultural misunderstandings,

Cilji in kompetence:

Cilji so usposobiti slušatelje, da bodo poznali:

- osnove kulturnih kompetenc in njihov pomen za kakovostno delo z bolniki iz drugih kulturnih okolij
- ključna mednarodna in nacionalna določila, ki urejajo zdravstveno oskrbo za različne kategorije migrantov,
- orodja za pomoč pri delu z bolniki, ki ne govorijo slovenskega jezika
- osnovne smernice za sodelovanje s kulturnimi mediatorji in tolmači v zdravstvenem sistemu.

Bodo razumeli:

- pomen kulturnih kompetenc za kakovostno delo z bolniki ter različna orodja in sodelavce, ki se v proces boljše oskrbe lahko vključujejo
- etične in finančne posledice pomanjkljive komunikacije z bolniki iz drugih kulturnih in jezikovnih okolij,

Bodo poznali:

- pravne in etične vidike organizacije dela v zdravstvu ob prisotnosti tolmačev in kulturnih mediatorjev,
- problematiko neformalnih prevajalcev (sorodniki, znanci, neizobraženo osebje..)

Objectives and competences:

The aim of the programme is to teach students to acquire knowledge of:

- the basics of cultural competences and of their importance for a high-quality work with patients from other cultural environments,
- key international and national regulations that define healthcare for different categories of migrants,
- basic tools provided for work with patients who do not speak Slovene,
- basic guidelines for work with cultural mediators and interpreters in healthcare system,

To understand:

- the importance of cultural competences for a high-quality work with patients, of different tools and of collaboration with different professional profiles that enable more efficient healthcare provision,
- the ethical and financial consequences of badly managed communication with patients from other cultural and linguistic environments,

Will be familiar with

- legal and ethical aspects of the organisation of labour in healthcare in the presence of interpreters and healthcare workers,

Understanding the basic principles of including patients into decision taking, participatory healthcare and patient-centered healthcare, and of the duty to inform the patient, 5. Knowledge of conflict management strategies, 6. Knowledge of complaint handling strategies, 7. Understanding professionalism and humanism in primary healthcare, 8.
