Cilji:

Študent pri izbirnem predmetu razširjeno in poglobljeno obravnava ozko izbrano temo iz celotnega obsega vsebin izbranega predmeta. Obravnava presega raven obravnave v učbeniku. Pri izbranem predmetu študent utrjuje znanja in veščine, potrebne za samostojno delo in razčlenjevanje posameznih problemov na osnovi podatkov, dobljenih iz sodobne strokovne literature. Hkrati s tem utrjuje znanja in veščine, potrebne za samostojno iskanje sodobnih virov podatkov iz izbranega področja, njihovo razčlenjevanje, analizo in predstavitev. Cilj je priprava študenta na samostojno obravnavo in predstavitev posameznih tem na osnovi tekočih dogajanj v stroki.

Objectives:

Student will acquire extended and in-depth knowledge in a specific topic from the entire scope of thematic units of the selected subject and surpass the textbook level of dealing with a specific subject matter. The selected subject enables the student to consolidate knowledge and skills necessary for independent work and classification of specific problems on the basis of information obtained from up-to-date professional literature. By doing so, the student consolidates knowledge and skills necessary for independent search of up-to-date information from the selected subject, their classification, analysis, and representation. The objective is to prepare the student for independent treatment and presentation of individual thematic units on the basis of current field activities.
