Nomination procedures	New nomination system: through this form.
	After receiving your nomination, we will send an email to your students, with you in CC, to ask them to fill out a more complete form including information like:
	 During which period would the student like to come to Barcelona?
	 In which areas would the student like to rotate (internal medicine, hematology, rheumatology, general surgery, obstetrics, etc.)?
	- How many weeks per area?
	As a new update, we are asking students to include a reference letter.
	*Note that rotations are no longer than 16 weeks and a maximum of 4 weeks per specialty.
Language requirements	B2 in Spanish. Native speakers do not need to provide the certificate. The OLS language test is not accepted as proof of students' language level.
Other requirements	 GPA equal to or above 1.7 (scale 1-4) Only students in their last year of studies are accepted.

Clinical rotation request	Once students are officially nominated, they will receive an online form to select their rotation details. Students' requests have to be approved by their home university academic coordinator.
Placements confirmation	Once the nomination deadline is over (May) our Medicine department will allocate students' placements. We will inform students accordingly and they will have one week to accept the proposal and send us the required documents. NOTE: Placement allocation will depend on the hospital's availability, dates and specialties selected.
Application procedure	 After placement confirmation, students should complete the application process with UIC Barcelona (<u>exchange.scu@uic.es</u>) to get the acceptance letter. Students should also send the specific documents for clinical rotation to <u>movilidadmedicina@uic.es</u> (see next section).
Documents required for clinical rotations (MANDATORY)	 Confidentiality commitment of the hospital Vaccination card: Triple viral (measles, mumps, rubella) DTP (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis) poliomyelitis Hepatitis B Varicella (you need to be vaccinated or bring a medical certificate confirming that the disease has passed) Covid 19
