Offered Courses	A full-time student can expect a normal academic workload of 30 ECTS credits in a single semester and 60 ECTS credits over a complete academic year. The credits allocated to courses and therefore the number of courses a student can take may vary.

	Please note that our incoming students will have to choose at least 70% of their courses within the Department with which the agreement was signed.





Language Requirements	Standard language requirement to study at UoC: B2 level in English according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for languages).
	Please refer to the Erasmus+ inter-Institutional agreement signed with your Institution formore specific requirements.
	Depending on the course and class size, special arrangements for instruction in English may be possible for Erasmus+ students (to be discussed with each course coordinator). However, in most cases, taught courses are offered in Greek. Students, who do not speak Greek, receive tutoring, supervision and in some Departments an examination in the English language.
